Thank you for your information request received by the Policy team at Mid and East Antrim Borough Council (MEABC) on 15th May 2024 which has been processed under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

Your request:

'Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000, I would like to know:

- 1. Has your local authority employed debt collection agencies to collect unpaid council tax debts or business rates over the last five years?
- 2. Has your local authority employed bailiffs to collect unpaid council tax debts or business rates over the last five years?
- 3. Has your local authority applied for any bankruptcy petitions against people with unpaid council tax debts or business rates over the last five years? If so, how many?
- 4. Has your local authority applied for any charging orders against people with unpaid council tax debts or business rates over the last five years? If so, how many?
- 5. Has your local authority "sold" any books of council tax or business rates debt over the last five years?'

Our response:

This information is regarded as *not held* for the purposes of the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

Council tax does not apply in Northern Ireland, the equivalent is a rating system for both domestic and business properties. Domestic and/or Business rates comprise a 'district' rate set by local Councils which is added to a regional rate which is set at the NI Assembly.

The total rateable value is administered and enforced by the Department of Finance through Land and Property Services. Please see the following URL that may assist you in locating this information:
